

## Possible Mandarin Chinese After-School Program

Valley Catholic Middle School students have the opportunity to enroll in an after-school Chinese Language program for students in grades 6 – 8. Curriculum will include speaking and listening as well as developing the student’s natural curiosity to ignite their international mindedness, and become caring and active members of the international community.

Classes will be taught by Guimin Tang, a native Chinese with strong Chinese and English language skills. Mr. Tang graduated from Guangdong University of Foreign Studies with a Master’s degree in Linguistics and Applied Linguistics. He also has a Masters degree in Education from Portland State University. He was as a 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade instructor at the Portland French School until the school’s closure this past May. Mr. Tang is currently a doctoral student in Graduate School of Education, Portland State University

Classes will meet on THURSDAYS for 50 minutes from 3:25-4:15pm in the Middle School building. Class size will be limited to 15 students per class.
