



## VALLEY CATHOLIC MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2009 – 2010

**This is the basic supply list.** Class-specific supply lists will be provided during the first few weeks of school, should any additional supplies be needed.

**Items to have in your book bag/locker for all classes** (a second set is strongly recommended to have at home): Used supplies are acceptable. **Do not purchase new supplies if you have USABLE used supplies from previous years** (especially colored pencils, crayons, scissors, calculator, eraser, ruler, dictionary, glue, etc.).

1. School-issued homework/agenda planner (Available at book buying/registration day)
2. # 2 pencils with erasers
3. Traditional blue or black ballpoint pens
4. Red or green ball point correcting pens
5. Loose-leaf college ruled paper (500 sheets recommended)
6. 3 x 5 lined WHITE index cards (500 recommended for the school year)
7. Colored pencils and/or **Crayola** brand crayons (set of 24 recommended)
8. Thin colored Markers (at least a set of 8)
9. Highlight pens - Two different colors
10. Portable, manual pencil sharpener (the kind that collects shavings)
11. Scissors
12. Pink Pearl eraser or extra eraser toppers
13. Metric ruler
14. Liquid glue stick or Elmer's liquid glue
15. Poly expanding file jacket (not cardstock style) – 13 files minimum
16. College dictionary
17. Basic function scientific calculator - not a graphing calculator (will be used second semester)
18. Five 22 x 28 white poster papers (to have at home for various projects)
19. Two tri-fold display boards, 36" x 48", white (for science fair in March and religion project in April)
20. Portable three-hole punch

The following items are often required to be left in the classroom. Students will not be able to use the binder and notebook for another class. Color choices are recommended for student organizational purposes. Please try to comply with color requests whenever possible.

21. Graph Paper 4 x 4 squares per inch (50 sheets or more)
22. Four sets of divider tabs (at least 5 tabs each set – set of 8 recommended)
23. Four – three prong report covers
24. Two one-inch three-ring binders – recommended colors: red (health), green (science)  
\*8<sup>th</sup> grade Japanese students will need an additional three-ring binder
25. Six spiral style notebooks (100 pages or more per notebook). Recommended colors:  
green (science), black (English), red (social studies), blue (study skills), purple (Religion),  
plus one extra (Probably for math)
26. Paper towels (one roll)
27. A large box of Kleenex/tissues

**RECOMMENDED BUT NOT REQUIRED:**

- Locker shelf (locker size 13 ½ D x 11 ½ W x 32 ½ H to hooks) and locker mirror
- Book covers (do not use contact paper)
- USB flash drive
- Pencil pouch/box/etc.
- Magnetized pencil cup or box that holds pens on the locker door

## Other Required Supplies:

### **PE Uniform (required for all MS students)**

- Solid black or navy shorts (MUST BE PURCHASED FROM DENNIS UNIFORM OR LANDS END). PE shorts may not be any shorter than 2" above the knee and no longer than mid-calf. SMV PE shorts are not acceptable.
- T-shirt must have a VCMS/VCS/SMVGS/CYO logo/association/camp or be solid white
- PE Shoes

Students rent PE locks from the school. A \$5.00 fee for the padlock to use on the P.E. basket/locker will be collected on registration day. The \$5.00 is refundable at the end of the school year upon return of the school-issued lock.

### **Music Classes (required for all MS students)**

(Band/Choir/Orchestra– all students)

- Navy Blue Twill Uniform Pants (from Dennis Uniform or Lands End)
- Long Sleeved Blue Oxford with logo (from Dennis Uniform)
- Tie from Dennis Uniform (Neck tie for boys, cross-over tie for girls)

### **Emergency Kit Supplies (required for all MS students)**

This kit will be kept in the students' homeroom class in case an emergency (such as an earthquake or severe ice storm) should occur that would detain the students at school for several unexpected hours.

***Please put all supplies in a GALLON SIZED ZIPLOCK BAG (Approx. 10 ½" x 11") with the student's first and last name written in BOLD PERMANENT MARKER on the outside of the bag.***

- Two –(approx. 9 oz) bottles of water
- Several **HEALTHY** non-perishable snacks – enough to last for 9 hours (fruit rolls, granola bar, jerky, dried fruit, crackers, etc.)
- Foil blanket and antibacterial wipes
- Two quart sized Ziploc baggies
- A pocket sized Kleenex/tissue pack
- Two hand warmers, instant heat therapy wrap, etc.
- Instant ice bag
- A Sharpie permanent marker (any color) and a small pad of paper (4" x 6" or smaller)
- Any medication for a pre-diagnosed life threatening condition (Bee sting/Epi-pen, Inhaler, etc.)
- A deck of playing cards
