Fees and Tuition

*This Registration Form with sign-ups for Summer Camp weeks is due by May 28 for all summer camps. All registrations received after May 28 are subject to availability.

* Only one child per form. Please complete all sections in blue or black ink, printing clearly.

* Please complete and return this registration form by above due dates.

* If form is returned after due date and up to the day before the school closure, space is subject to availability and the fee must be paid at the time of request.

Payment Procedures

* For your convenience, payment in full may be made with the Registration Form or billed on a monthly basis.

* Balances for June starting dates will be billed June 9 and due in full by June 14.

Balances for July starting dates will be billed July 1 and due in full by July 7.

Balances for August starting dates will be billed August 1 and due in full by August 7.

*Checks returned to us by the bank will incur a \$35.00 charge. All future payments will have to be made with a money order or cashier's check.

Cancellations and Refunds

*All activity fees and tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable. Tuition for students who leave for behavioral reasons will not be refunded. For cancellations other than verifiable medical reasons, tuition paid in advance will not be refunded. Please see the Director if there is a verifiable medical reason for withdrawal.

*At the close of business on the due date, school closure forms are processed and VCELS will not issue credit for these days not attended, (this includes incorrectly filled out forms).

*Weeks will not be prorated. For students attending another VCS Campus Camp, before and after camp care may be available on a prorated basis. Please see Director for details and registration.

Sunscreen Authorization

All children attending summer camp must have a signed sunscreen authorization (see Registration Form). VCELS will supply sunscreen to be applied during summer camp.

Field Trip Authorization

All children attending summer camp must have a signed field trip authorization (see Registration Form). Parents will be given all details of field trips in writing no later than the Monday of the week that the field trip will take place.
