## PRELUDE

### Beginning Violin:

- All age levels with instrument
- Learn the basics of holding and playing the violin. By the end of the week students will be able to play simple tunes with the bow.
- Good head start for Valley Catholic 4th grade violin class!

### Beginning Piano:

- For Kindergartners with no piano experience
- Must know how to read
- Eye and ear training
- Prerequisite: preschoolers must be able to concentrate and focus for 20 minutes at a time
- Rhythm, theory and keyboard

## SESSION I

### Violin I:

- Grades 2nd through 5th, Valley Catholic 4th grade violin class, or 1+ years of study.
- Learn and improve ensemble and orchestra skills.
- Activities include sight-reading bowing techniques and rhythmic skills.
- Further develop musicality and tone production

### Piano I:

- A fun and exciting week for students with one to two years of piano lessons. Students will concentrate on the fundamentals of music by strengthening their skills in note-reading and counting while playing solos and duets. Theory will also be included.

### Barbershop:

- Study a rich variety of barbershop literature
- Rehearsals include vocal warm-ups, breathing techniques, and rhythmic exercises
- Experience the fun of learning to hold a harmony

## SESSION II

### Orchestra:

- Most instruments welcome
- 3+ years of study & intermediate note reading on their current instrument
- This class will also include music theory & will conclude with a performance at the final concert.
- Learn ensemble skills in an orchestra setting
- Improve sight reading & rhythmic skills

### Piano II:

- This class is geared for students who have had at least two years of piano. The week will include activities that will enhance and advance current skills in insight-reading and counting. Also covered will be technique, musicianship and Theory
- Able to read notes— Required
