- The design will be in one color, black.
- All entries must be submitted in “photo ready” images – black line drawings with no stray pencil marks, accurate spelling, and accurate sizing of all images including text. An electronic version is also acceptable.

All entries are due no later than Friday, April 24 2009. Voting of all entries that follow the above requirements will take place in April by the eighth grade class.
