



# Scrip: a “FUN”draiser!

**“What is Scrip?”** Here are answers to commonly asked questions about the **Valley Catholic Scrip Program**.

**~Scrip is:** The easiest and most widely used School fundraiser. It’s used nation wide in schools, churches and non-profit organizations.

**~Scrip is:** A “gift card”, **except** you can use it for the everyday shopping **YOU DO**. Groceries, coffee, Macy’s, JC Penney, restaurants, ice cream stores, to name a few. These merchants provide the “gift cards” at a discount to the school, then the school sells the gift cards at face value to you, the parents. Scrip has no additional mark up to you.

**~Scrip is:** A “no cost” fund raiser. It’s not something you buy that sits in your closet to be forgotten. Are you going to Fred Meyer to buy groceries? Buy your Scrip card **FIRST**. It will benefit your school.

**~Scrip is:** Easy to keep organized. Keep all your cards in (1) ready to find place, such as a separate wallet. Then the cards are ready to use when you buy groceries or pick up that pizza after the game.
