Freshman Scholarship Application Requirements

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

To apply for the ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP, you must submit:

1. A letter of recommendation from a teacher addressing the student's accomplishments and industry.
2. A copy of the student's transcript and standardized test scores from the sixth grade to the present.
Note: This transcript is separate from the Student Application transcript.
3. An essay on a book, person, experience, or activity that has been very important to you.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

To apply for the MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP, you must submit:

1. A letter of recommendation from a music teacher.
2. A list of musical experiences.
3. Auditions will be held on Saturday, February 18, 2012. Pre-register for your audition by calling the school office. The audition may include:
 - a) Instrumentalist--major scales in two octaves and two pieces of music from instrumental repertoire.
 - b) Vocalists--two pieces of music to showcase the student's skills. Selections are to be chosen from musicals or vocal literature.

ART SCHOLARSHIP

To apply for the ART SCHOLARSHIP, you must submit:

1. A letter of recommendation from an art teacher.
2. A list of art experiences.
3. A portfolio of art which includes:
 - a) Three of your best art pieces from school.
 - b) One piece of art done out of school that is from life, such as a drawing of a dog, a person, or still life.
