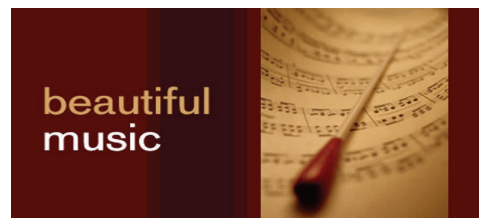

PRELUDE

Beginning Violin & Viola

This class is for students, ages 4 and up, with no prior experience on the violin or viola. Students will learn the basics of holding and playing the violin/viola. By the end of the week, students will be able to play simple tunes with the bow. For older students, this class is a good “head start” for Valley Catholic’s 4th grade violin class.

Prerequisite: Each student must be able to provide their own instrument.

Beginning Piano

This class is for new piano players who have at least a twenty-minute attention span, are able to read print and have no piano experience. Beginning piano will focus on learning the keyboard, letter names of notes, and rhythms. These fundamental aspects of music will be reinforced through eye and ear training and musical games. At the end of the week, students will have an opportunity to perform an easy piano piece that they have learned.

Prerequisite: None

SESSION I

Violin I

This class is for violinists going into 1st—5th grade. The class will focus on developing individual skill in music theory, sight reading, bowing technique and rhythm skills. Students will spend a lot of time playing their instruments, as well as participating in other activities that will build their knowledge of music. Students in this class will gain experience playing in a small ensemble, learn to follow a conductor and will have the opportunity to perform as a group at the end of the week.

Prerequisite: Students should have had at least one year of private lessons or have completed Valley Catholic’s 4th grade violin class.

Piano I

This class will be a fun and exciting week for students with one to two years of piano lessons. Students will concentrate on the fundamentals of music by strengthening their skills in note reading and counting, while playing solos and duets. Theory will also be included. Students will have an opportunity to perform pieces they have learned at the concert on Friday.

Prerequisite: One to two years of piano lessons.

Barbershop

Through barbershop harmonies, students will double their skill capacity to hold a part and at the same time explore some of the Barbershop tunes of years ago. Students will work on extending their range and projection. Stage presence, articulation and pronunciation will be stressed. Students will have an opportunity at the end of the week to show family and friends what they have learned.

SESSION II

Piano II

This week will include activities that will enhance and advance current skills in sight-reading and counting. Piano technique, musicianship and theory will also be covered. At the end of the week, students will have the opportunity to perform for family and friends.

Prerequisite: Students should have had at least two years of piano and have no trouble reading music.

Orchestra

This class will give students experience playing in an orchestral setting, where they can improve their sight reading and rhythmic skills. Students will enjoy playing as a large group and in sectionals, in addition to participating in activities to strengthen their knowledge of music theory. Students will have an opportunity to perform in the orchestra at the final concert on Friday.

Prerequisite: Students should have three or more years experience on their instrument and be able to read music at an intermediate level.
