



*Thank you for volunteering with Willamette West Habitat for Humanity!
We are excited to have your help on our current project. Below is
all the information you should need for your day of volunteering*

WHERE: We are currently building at our Hunting Park Neighborhood, located on SW Sussex St and Hall Blvd in Beaverton; Sussex is located between Denny Rd and Allen Ave. From Highway 217, take exit #2B (Allen Ave), or #3 (Denny Rd) depending on what direction you are coming from. Proceed to Hall Blvd and turn on 22nd. If you are coming from the West, you can get to Hall Blvd via Murray Rd or TV Highway.

PARKING: Limited parking is available at the Beaverton Church of the Nazarene in the Southeast corner of their parking lot; carpooling is encouraged. To get into the parking lot, turn west onto SW 22nd and right into the church parking lot.

TRAINING: Volunteers will be trained each day to do whatever project is being done on your given volunteer day. During your morning training, we will give you a safety orientation.

THE RULES:

- If you can't make your volunteer day, please notify Erin at the Habitat office, at 503-844-7606 ext. 111 or through e-mail at erinmaxey@habitatwest.org, as soon as you know. 24 hour's notice is appreciated.
- Minors (14-17) **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or guardian (must be over 21). For every two (2) 14-15 year old there must be one (1) adult supervisor. For every four (4) 16-17 years old there must be one (1) adult supervisor.
- Please arrive on the worksite promptly at 8:15 am for the training. The work day will end at approximately 4:00 pm.
- Once on site, be sure to sign in/out with the site supervisor.
- If you haven't already done so, please be sure to complete liability waiver when you arrive. Waivers need to be filled out every calendar year, ex. 2010 or 2011.

Helpful Hints for Volunteering

- Wear closed toe shoes – heavy gym shoes or work boots are preferred.
- Dress for the weather: we work rain or shine. Wear pants and other comfortable clothing, layering is recommended. Be prepared to work with mud and paint, please wear clothes you don't mind getting dirty.
 - The worksite will be closed if Beaverton School Districts or closed.
 - The worksite will be closed if the weather is below 28 degrees or above 94 degrees.
- Habitat will provide all of the necessary tools. If you have a favorite hammer or tool belt, you are welcome to bring it, but please be sure it is well marked.
- Lunch is from 12:00-12:30 pm. Bring a sack lunch. There is a refrigerator and microwave on site, but no other cooking equipment. Filtered water is available.
- Clean up at the end of the day is **VERY** important.
- Remember: **BE SAFE** and have **FUN!**
