



# 2020 – 2021 At Home Supply List

This is the basic list to start off the school-year while students are participating in Digital Learning. Specialty courses and class projects may require additional supplies. However, every attempt was made to create as comprehensive a list while keeping costs as minimal as possible.

Used supplies are acceptable/encouraged. **Do not purchase new supplies if you have USABLE supplies from previous years** (especially colored pencils, crayons, scissors, calculator, eraser, ruler, glue, folders, etc.).

## Basic Supplies

All students will use an online agenda planner to coordinate with Google Classroom information.

1. #2 pencils and/or mechanical pencils
2. A large pink pearl eraser
3. Ball point pens: dark blue or black, red or green
4. Loose-leaf college ruled paper
5. Four 1.5" three-ringed binders
6. Four sets of divider tabs – 5 tabs or more
7. Four one subject notebooks
8. Colored pencils
9. One set of thin colored markers (at least a set of 8)
10. One set of wide colored markers (at least a set of 8)
11. Two black permanent markers
12. Crayons (at least a set of 24)
13. Highlighters - Two different colors
14. Scissors
15. One 12 inch ruler with both cm and inches
16. Four Glue sticks
17. Double-sided tape
18. Basic scientific calculator – (A graphing calculator is not needed in middle school)
19. Protractor for measuring angles
20. Graph paper, loose leaf or notebook (recommend 80 sheets+)
21. Set of 250+ index cards (lined on one side)
22. Four+ 22x 28 poster/railroad boards (not tri-fold)
23. One set of basic ear buds or head phones
24. A good stylus (mid-level [this one](#) or cheaper alternative [here](#))
25. Pack of colored paper/construction paper (recommended, not required)
26. Two-Three reams of printer paper

Do not purchase art supplies until class placement is confirmed. This is for planning purposes only.
